Seesaw

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Thank you to all the parents who have connected to their child's learning journey on seesaw. It has been wonderful interacting with you all and the children have really enjoyed sharing their learning. To maximise the use of this amazing tool, you can add to their learning journals from home! You can add: anything that relates to their learning at school, any extra homework your child has done, or photographs/videos of exciting experiences your child has had (like special days out).

Reading books

Children are now going to take **reading tests** at school. They will take a test for each book they read. To support your child on this test, please listen to them reading at home for a minimum of 10 minutes. You could also ask them questions about the book to increase their understanding of the events. The results of the tests will indicate the level your child should be reading at. This allows us to provide a book with the correct level of challenge. It will also indicate when your child is ready to move on to the next level.

English focus:

We are going to focus on writing longer pieces in English using all the skills we have been taught.

Maths focus:

We are going to be learning about fractions, position/direction, place value and time. In our place value topic, we will be working with larger 2-digit numbers.
