What we are currently learning:

In Maths this half term we are focusing on number and place value, ensuring the children have a solid and secure knowledge of counting, which is crucial before we begin moving onto other aspects of Maths.

In Literacy we will be writing based off of the Julia Donaldson book 'Sharing a Shell' which links to our overarching Topic this half term, 'A Place in The sun'.

The children will learn crucial Geography skills as we begin to understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom, and of a small area in a contrasting non-European country.

In Science the children will be learning about 'Living Things and their Habitat'.
