What we are currently learning:

In our English lessons we will continue to focus on the grammar requirements for Upper KS2 and prepare for our tests.

- Ensuring that children complete all homework and return it by Thursday. This is an expectation that children will complete their homework.

Our English focus:

We will be studying a book called 'The Arrival' and we will use the text to write letters and a diary extract.

Our Maths focus:

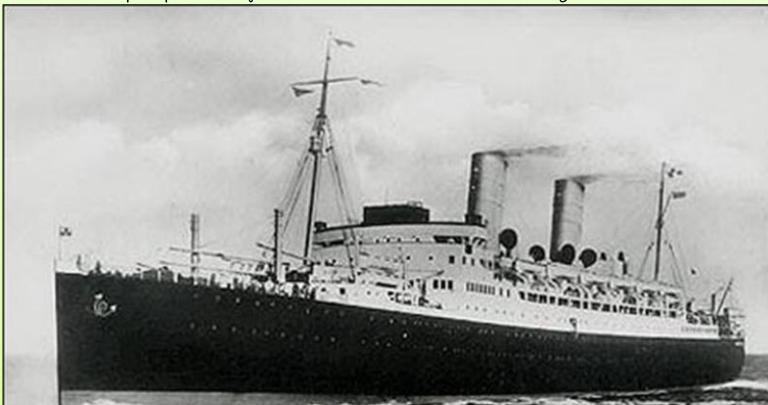
Our main focus will be on number and place value. We will also recap our skills of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
