

Our club is stationed in the school building, near the school office. We open from 2:45 pm till 5:30 pm daily and offer places to children from both Dean Field and St Malachy's.

The club is managed by Miss Daniella Booth who also works throughout school as our Senior Inclusion Support Worker. Miss Booth has worked at Dean Field for over four years and has previous experience working in a before and after School Club. Working alongside Miss Booth we have newly appointed Miss Georgia Rae and Miss Jessica Woodhead.

The club setting allows us to offer an array of continuous provision. Children can choose to just chill and watch a film, listen to music or complete homework in one of our three rooms.

There is always creative drawing or art activities on offer. Other activities include dressing up, large and small construction alongside board games and jigsaws. We have a choice of games for the Wii which the children seem to particularly enjoy.

Outdoor provision is offered on a daily basis (weather permitting) and we are fortunate to have access to the school field and playgrounds, where the children can play football, other balls games and use the climbing frames. As part of their time at our Out of School Club the children are given a snack and drink. The snack options changes daily are vary from pizza making, baking and cheese toasties to soup and pasta. Fruit is always available.
