- Mill owners and cloth merchants were the jobs of people living at the Shibden Estate.
- A merchant was somebody who sold and traded goods such as cloth. Cloth was traded at the Piece Hall.
- Percy Shaw, a local men, invented cat's eyes. They are used on roads to make them safer.
- Items inside Shibden Estate from the 18th century and 19th century can be called artefacts.
