






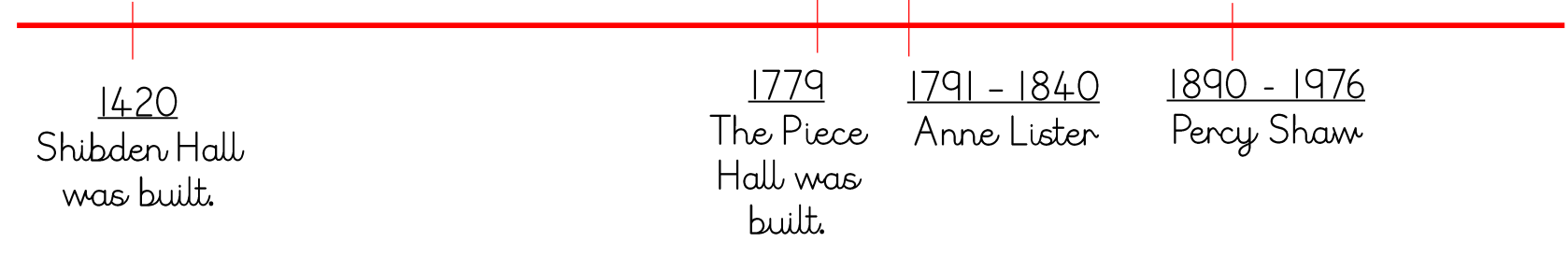

 19th Century	The 19th century was the century from 1801 to 1900.
The Piece Hall	When it was first built in 1779, the Piece Hall was used for trading pieces of cloth.

Anne Lister was born in 1791 and died in 1840. She owned Shibden Estate in 1836. Anne Lister wrote diaries and taught us lots about what life was like in Halifax in the past.

- Shibden Estate was founded in 1420 in Halifax.
- Anne Lister was part of the Lister family and they owned the Shibden Estate.
- She kept a diary which has taught us about life in Halifax at that time.
- Mill owners and cloth merchants were the jobs of people living at the Shibden Estate.
- A merchant was somebody who sold and traded goods such as cloth. Cloth was traded at the Piece Hall.
- Percy Shaw, a local man, invented cat's eyes. They are used on roads to make them safer.
- Items inside Shibden Estate from the 18th century and 19th century can be called artefacts.
