

Assessment Week

Children in years 1, 3, 4 and 5 will be completing assessments next week. This will mean they will be taking reading and maths tests in order to assess where they are in their learning. It's very important that all children take these assessments as a key priority for us as a school is to ensure our teacher assessment judgments at the end of this year are accurate.

You will be informed about your child's attainment and how this compares to their age in their end of year report. You will also have the opportunity to discuss your child's report in more detail at our end of year Parents' Evening on Thursday 19th July 2-6pm.

A reminder that our Summer Fayre this year will be held on **Wednesday 18th July** from **2:30pm** onwards. School will finish early on this day to allow parents and children plenty of time to enjoy the fayre. If you are not able to collect your children until the normal time of 3pm they will remain supervised by an adult until you collect them. 
