Marie Curie



- Marie Curie was a physicist and chemist and a pioneer in the study of radiation.
- She and her husband, Pierre, discovered the elements polonium and radium.
- Together, they were awarded the Nobel Prize for Physics in 1903, and she received another one, for Chemistry, in 1911.
- Her work with radioactive materials doomed her, however. She died of a blood disease in 1934.
