## Safe Guarding Sun Protection

### **Sun safety tips**

Spend time in the shade when the sun is strongest. In the UK, this is between 11am and 3pm from March to October.

Make sure you:

- spend time in the shade between 11am and 3pm
- make sure you never burn
- cover up with suitable clothing and sunglasses
- take extra care with children

use at least factor 30 sunscreen

**What factor sunscreen (SPF) should I use?**

Do not rely on sunscreen alone to protect yourself from the sun. Wear suitable clothing and spend time in the shade when the sun's at its hottest.

When buying sunscreen, the label should have:

- a sun protection factor (SPF) of at least 30 to
- at least 4-star UVA protection

UVA protection can also be indicated by the letters "UVA" in a circle, which indicates that it meets the EU standard.

Make sure the sunscreen is not past its expiry date. Most sunscreens have a shelf life of 2 to 3 years.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY



Please be aware of our uniform policy set out below when purchasing new uniform for your child for September.

### School Uniform

School uniform is compulsory. At Dean Field our uniform is:

A **royal blue** jumper or cardigan (with or without the school's logo on it)

A **pale blue** polo shirt or pale blue collared shirt

**Grey** or **black** trousers/skirts/dresses

**Grey** or **black** tights with skirts and dresses or in the summer white socks

**Pale blue** gingham summer dresses for girls in the summer

**Grey** or **black** shorts for the boys in the summer

Footwear should be **black**, safe, sensible and weather appropriate. **High heels and back-less shoes are not permitted for safety reasons.**

**Please note that from September white polo shirts and white collared shirts will not be allowed. Pupils must only wear pale blue polo shirts or collared shirts; this has always been the uniform policy of the school. For pupils in years 5 and 6 there will be the option for them to purchase a blue tie from the school office.**

Sweatshirts and T-shirts with the Dean Field logo may be purchased from ZIGGYS Schoolwear Halifax, parents may decide to dress their children in **royal** blue jumpers/cardigans to match in with the school sweatshirt.

We **STRONGLY** recommend that you put your child's name in their uniform and talk to them about how to be responsible for it.

Sensible accessories such as headbands are permitted but caps and bandanas are **NOT** allowed to be worn indoors.

For PE children will need a pair of royal blue shorts and a plain white t-shirt. Children must bring tracksuit bottoms and trainers for outdoor PE activities. Children must provide their own sports kit for afterschool sport activities.

Jewellery is not allowed (except for studded earrings) for safety reasons, but children may wear a watch. Bracelets and wristbands are **NOT** allowed.

This information is carefully documented and forms part of our home-school agreement sent to parents/carers when their children enter the Early Years Foundation Stage or if a child joins the school at any time in KS1 or KS2.

We thank parents for their cooperation with our uniform policy.
