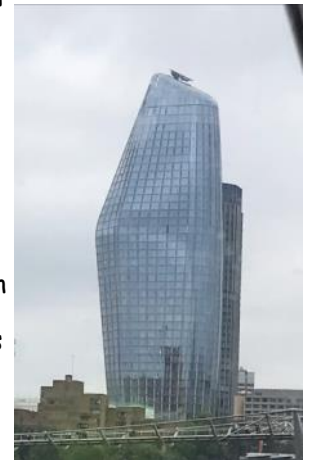
## Y5 Trip to London
