GUIDANCE FOR CHILDREN ON THE REOPENING OF SCHOOL FROM 8TH JUNE





You are probably wondering what school is going to look like when you return.

You might have already seen things on TV about how different school might look when you return and you may be feeling a little anxious or worried.

Hopefully this information will make you feel better about returning to school.





You will walk up the drive as normal with your parent or carer. Please make sure you keep your distance from other families.

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A member of staff will be at the top of the drive to welcome you and direct you.



If you are in **nursery** or **reception** or are with a **parent with a pram** then you will either go up these stairs or take the ramp up to the EYFS gate.

Nursery and reception children will queue outside their classrooms on the marked spots.

Parents with prams needing access to the main playground can make their way through the EYFS outdoor area.







Everyone else will slowly make their way up the stairs into the playground.

Remember if there are other families in front of you, give them their space and always stay with the parent or carer dropping you off.

The gates will open at 8.25 to allow plenty of time for people to get into the school grounds. Please do not come any earlier.





Year 1 children will be able to access the playground outside their classroom through these gates.

You will then see marked spots to show you where to stand and wait until you are allowed to enter school.







Years 2 to 6 will make their way into the main playground in the usual way up this path. This is a one way system so you can only walk up this way. To exit the playground you must go a different way.

You will then see marked spots in the playground to show you where to stand. Each year group will have its own marked spots which will be opposite your classroom. There will be adults to direct you where to stand. You must not play in the playground.







When you go home

Your parents will enter the playground at the end of the school day in the same way to collect you.

They will queue on the spots outside your classroom and then your teacher will dismiss the children one at a time.

You will then walk past the year 6 classroom and exit around the back of the school building. There will be adults to direct you where to go.





When you go home

To leave the school you will follow the path around the back of the building and then go through the gate pictured. Then down the path which can either bring you out onto Cousin Lane or you can walk past the house and down the opposite side of the school drive.

Mrs Mitchell will be there to direct you.
