

# RE Must Knows

## Year 2

- 2.1 It is important to welcome people and especially new babies into life. Infant Christians have a baptism ceremony and celebration. Muslims have a aqiqah ceremony and celebration.
- 2.2 People always face moral choices and rules are important. Christians follow the Ten Commandments for guidance on making good choices and following rules. Muslims use the Five Pillars of Islam for guidance on making good choices and following rules.
- 2.3 Prayer is important to those who belong to that religion. Why do people pray? E.g. forgiveness, to give thanks, for something. Christians use symbols to help them focus their prayer e.g. candles and the cross. Muslims use symbols to help them with their prayer e.g. prayer mat and compass to locate the direction of Makkah.
- 2.4 There are many ways we can reduce harm to the planet e.g. other forms of exercise so there are less emissions from vehicles on the road, recycling and reusing and litter in bins to prevent animals being hurt.
- 2.5 Jesus was 'called'. The most important rule Jesus gave to people was 'to love only God and love one another'. We can sequence the Easter story.
