Spelling Shed is a fun website where children can practise their weekly spellings by playing different spelling games! All children in year 1 - year 6 have their own individual logins and will have weekly assignments that have been set by their class teacher.

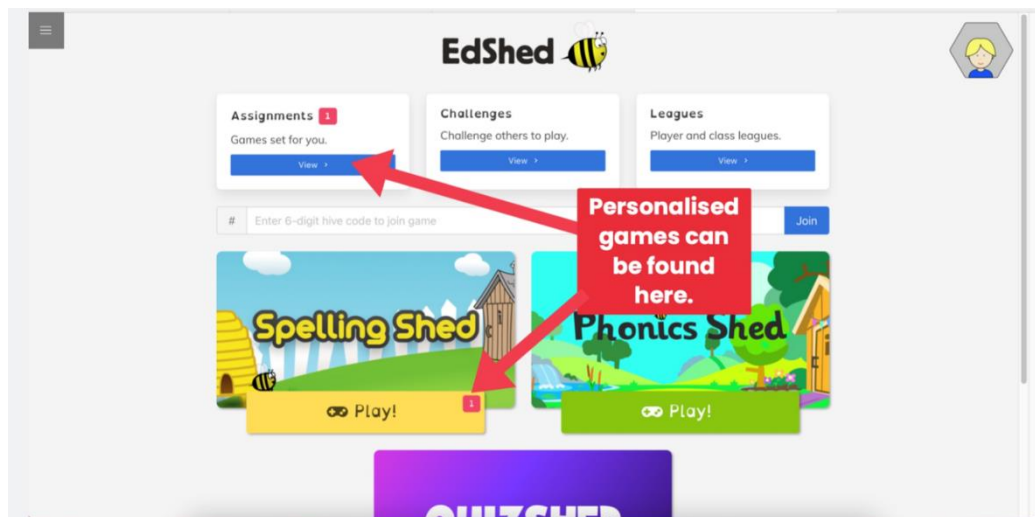
Here is a step-by-step guide that explains how you can help your child access spelling shed from home.



Visit <https://www.edshed.com/en-gb/login> and enter your child's username and password. Login details can be found at the back of your child's reading record.

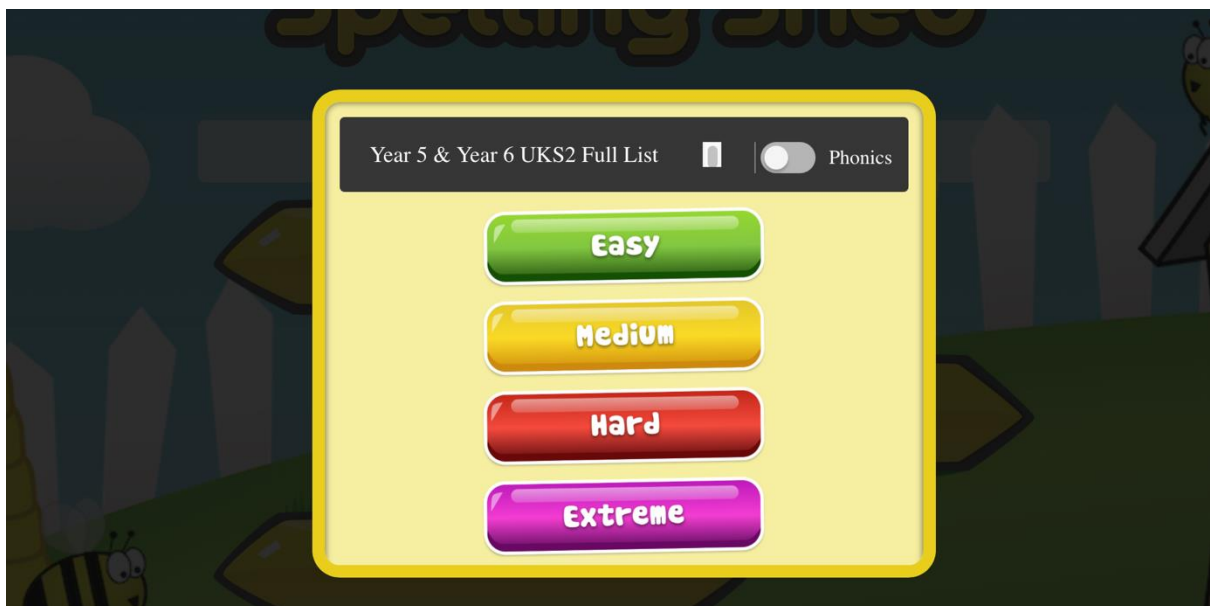
Once they have logged on, they will see the home screen below. On the home screen they will be able to access specific assignments that have been set by their class teacher. The assignments will include games that consist of their weekly spellings. The assignments will be updated each week to reflect their weekly spellings.



When you click on 'assignments' it will allow children to practise their weekly spellings and explore 'more lists.' The 'more lists' games are generic spelling games, which are supportive and beneficial but do not match your child's weekly spellings. Therefore, please encourage your child to complete the set assignments before playing other games.



When you have clicked on your child's assignment for the week, they will be given the option of a few different games to play. They will also be given the option to select the level of difficulty for each game from easy to extreme!
