A Parable is a simple story used to show a moral or spiritual lesson, as told by Jesus in the Gospels.

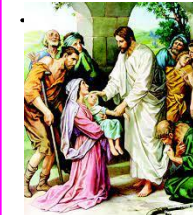
Forgiveness means letting go and forgetting past anger or wrong doing

The Parable of the Good Samaritan tells Christians how to live a good life.



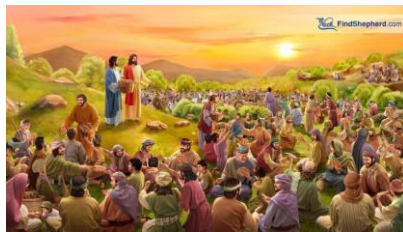
In the Old Testament there are important rules for Christians to follow.
