Waheguru - a word Sikhs use to refer to God as their 'wondrous enlightener'.

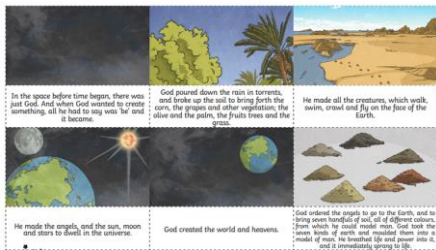
Jews, Christians and Muslims all have day of rest which is linked to their belief of the creation story.
