Code for living- Values that people live by. They can be religious and non religious.

Values - values are individual beliefs that motivate people to act one way or another.

Peace - Peace is a time without any fights or wars. It also means a state of quiet and calm.

Humanism- Humanists don't believe in God however have codes and morals of living.

Morality - is the concept of doing the right thing.

Consequences-a result of an action or situation.

A code for living is the values people live by.



Humanists have codes and morals of living without believing in God.



Peace is valued by Humanists, Muslim, Jews and Christians.



Values of Christianity include love, forgiveness, peace between people and God, honesty, prayer, worship and fellowship (togetherness).
