Speech and Language at Dean Field



At Dean Field we work with LINGO Speech and Language Therapists to develop the communication skills of children. Our therapist, Sarah Jones, is in school for a full day every other week to assess children's individual speech, language and communication needs, to help to provide personalised and specific speech therapy to children, to set up as well as monitor group interventions, to deliver training to school staff and to attend school events to support parents around their children's speech and language needs. If you feel that your child struggles with their speech, language and/or communication, please speak to your child's class teacher.
