Help + ing = helping

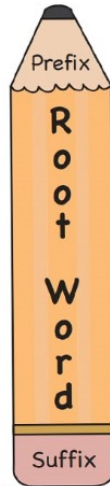
The **suffixes** I will learn this year are

Question marks for questions

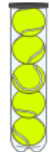
Plurals mean... More than One!
