

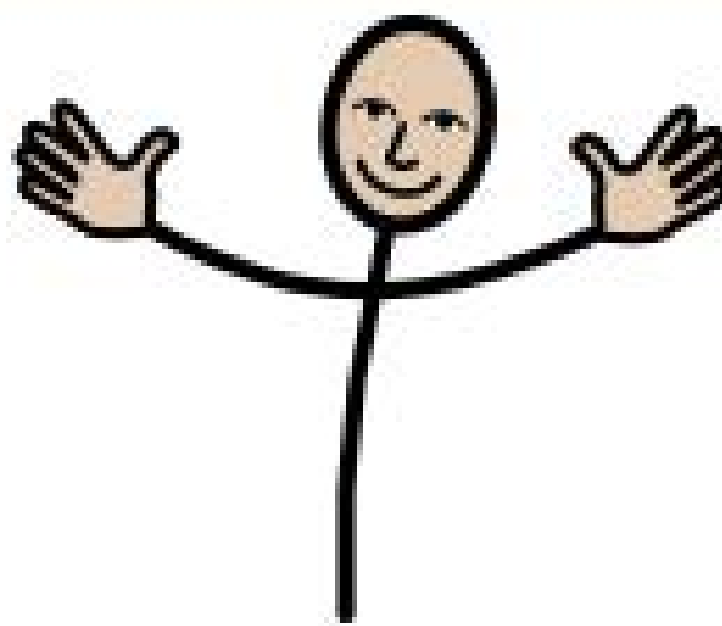



Learning Without Limits

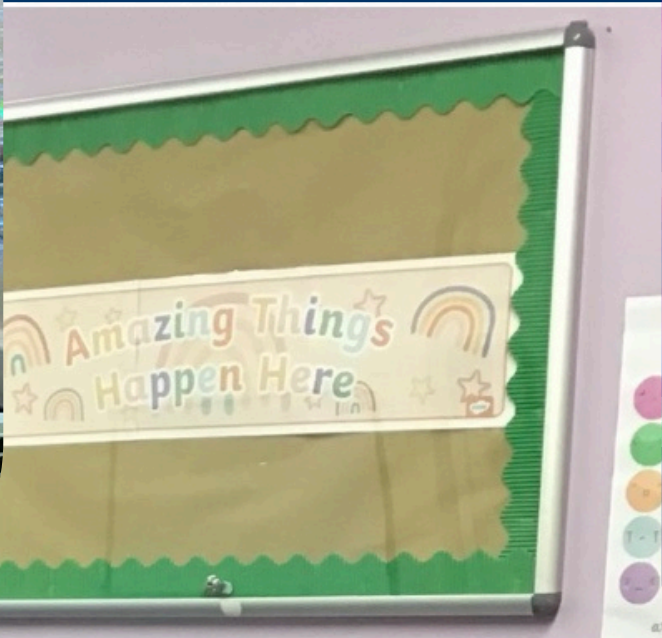
Our new resourced provision launched in September 2025 following a successful bid for funding from the local authority, and currently supports a small number of children with SEND to learn and succeed at school. The unit has a high staff ratio to ensure our pupils have the support needed to access school.



Our resourced provision is supported by a highly skilled and experienced team, carefully selected for their expertise in special educational needs. The provision is overseen by Miss Clay, our SENDCo, who ensures that pupils' individual needs are effectively met. Mrs Plowman, who teaches for half of the week, brings a wealth of knowledge in Early Years Foundation Stage and play-based learning. They are supported by Mrs Stephenson and Miss Pearson, both of whom have significant experience working in special school settings, bringing valuable skills and understanding to the team.

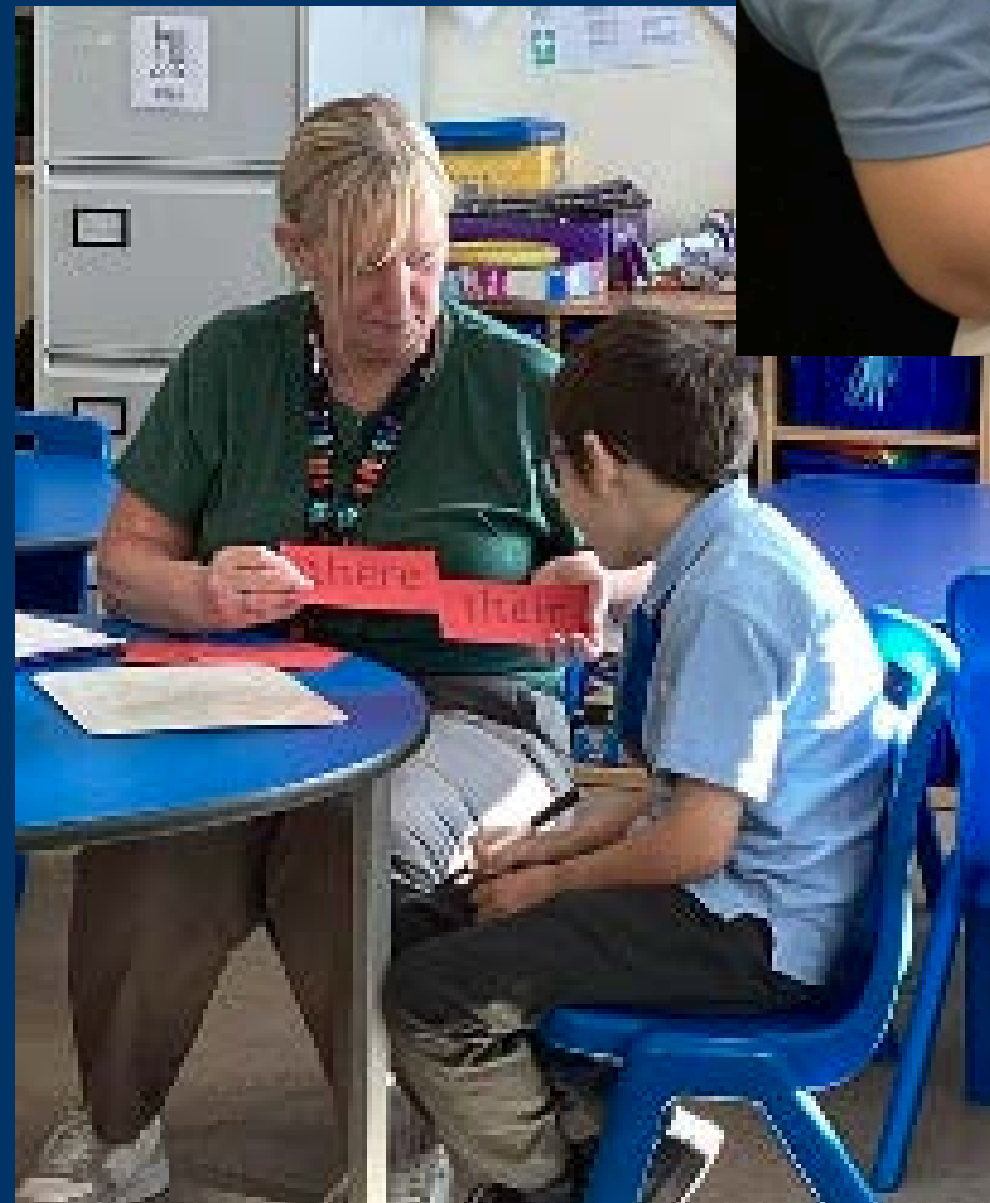
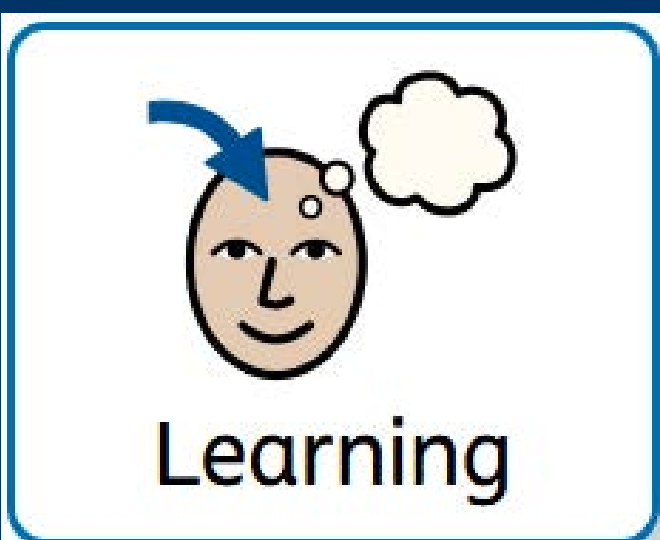


Sensory Room



Our sensory room allows children a space to regulate and calm, meeting their sensory processing needs.

We offer bespoke planning that follows the child's interests as well as supporting them to achieve National Curriculum outcomes to the best of their ability. Learning and outcomes for children are key priorities.



Learning is done in small groups or 1:1, and chunked appropriately. We foster independence and aim to build good attitudes for learning in a lower demand setting.


Our dedicated 'choose room' allows children the freedom to learn through play as they would in the Early Years.




It gives them the much needed break from formal learning that they need to remain calm and emotionally regulated.




